### ITINERARY:

#### Day 1 – DEPART BWI for arrival into SALT LAKE CITY

Join your escort and fellow travelers in Towson for transfer to the BWI airport; join at the airport, or in St Lake City if coming from other cities. Upon arrival, group transfers to your hotel are included. This evening, join your Local Guide, Accent On Travel host, and fellow travelers for a reception and light buffet.

#### Day 2 - SALT LAKE CITY - JACKSON

This morning, our orientation tour of Salt Lake City includes seeing historic Temple Square; we then travel across the Oregon Trail and visit historic Jackson, Wyoming. We will continue to our lakeside lodge overlooking Jackson Lake and the stunning peaks and glaciers of Grand Teton National Park.

#### Day 3 - JACKSON - YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, we explore Grand Teton National Park. Then enter Yellowstone, established in 1872 as the world's first national park and known for its unique geothermal activity, spectacular landscapes and abundant wildlife. Join a local guide for an informative stroll through Yellowstone's Upper Geyser Basin.

#### Day 4 - YELLOWSTONE SIGHTSEEING

Walk among the geysers in Yellowstone National Park and watch them erupt. See colorful bubbling mudpots and observe Old Faithful shooting water over 120ft in the air. View free-roaming herds of buffalo, deer, elk and bear in their natural habitat. Then experience the roar of the Lower Yellowstone Falls as they thunder down the steep canyon walls. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore or relax.

#### Day 5 - YELLOWSTONE - BILLINGS

Today, we depart Yellowstone and travel through the Shoshone Canyon and Absaroka Rocky Mountains to the historic Wild West town of Cody. Visit the Buffalo Bill Historical Center, built in honor of one of America's great western legends. Head onward to the old cattle town of Billings, Montana. Your centrally located hotel places you in the heart of this western rustic town.

#### Day 6 - BILLINGS - CUSTER STATE PARK

Relive "Custer's Last Stand" at the Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument and learn all about Sitting Bull, Crazy Horse and the history of the Indian Wars. Keep a lookout for pronghorn antelope while continuing across the great high plains to the Black Hills of South Dakota. In Deadwood, join Kevin Costner's Original Deadwood Tour and explore this once lawless town with a local expert. Relive the days of Wild Bill Hickok and Calamity Jane, who made this town famous during the gold rush of the 1870's. Continue on to Custer State Park, famous for its beautiful landscape and abundant wildlife. Look out for buffalo, deer and elk, or stroll through the pristine pine forest. After dinner, relax on the porch and take in the serenity of this amazing place.

## Day 7 - BLACK HILLS EXCURSION

Start the day at Crazy Horse Memorial, dedicated to all Native Americans, and the world's largest sculpture. Visit Mount Rushmore National Memorial, where the heads of Presidents Washington, Jefferson, Lincoln and Roosevelt dominate the Black Hills. Spend the rest of the day at leisure.

## Day 8 - CUSTER STATE PARK - CHEYENNE

Leave South Dakota to travel across the grasslands and high plains of Wyoming. Stop at historic Fort Laramie, a former frontier outpost of the U.S. Cavalry built along the Oregon Trail and witness to the sweeping saga of America's western expansion in the 19th Century. Continue to the Wild West town of Cheyenne, one of the great railroad junctions in America. Enjoy an orientation tour before arriving at your hotel.

## Day 9 - CHEYENNE - DENVER

Travel south and climb high into breathtaking Rocky Mountain National Park, across the Continental Divide and over Trail Ridge Road to follow the beginnings of the great Colorado River (weather permitting). Arrive at the Mile High City of Denver and view the city's highlights on an orientation tour before arriving at the hotel. In the evening, toast with fellow travelers the culmination of a fantastic adventure at a celebration dinner.

Passenger or immediate family is responsible to file with the insurance company to claim information for refund of cancellation penalties. The cost of insurance is non-refundable. Information on medical / cancellation insurance will be reviewed with your deposit. Cancellation penalties schedule prior to final payment are as follows:

Deposit to March 19 <sup>th</sup> , 2012:	\$50 per person
March 20 <sup>th</sup> – May 14 <sup>th</sup> , 2012:	\$300 per person
May 15 <sup>th</sup> – day of departure:	100% of vacation cost
